## Free 3 Hour Parking

- 3 - Sacajawea lot
- 4 - Matterhorn lot, 3 hour limit until 5 p.m.
- 6 - Wayside Chapel lot, no RVs,  
no public parking before noon Sunday
- 7 - Sinagua lot, no RVs, 3 hour limit until 5 p.m.

## 10 - Sedona Center

- 6 bus parking spaces
- Private Business
- Bus driver's lounge available
- Guaranteed parking for tours using Sedona Center Businesses

## Uptown Sedona parking

**Uptown Sedona is the destination** point for the majority of visitors with a variety of restaurants, galleries and shops.

The Visitor Center, located on the corner of SR89A and Forest Road, is a great first stop.

Sedona welcomes 3.0 million visitors a year. During the busiest times traffic can be heavy but there is generally parking available in Uptown if you know where to look.

In addition to parking provided by resorts and shops for customers, the city has nine parking lots with free parking, and metered pay-to-park spaces along SR89A in Uptown Sedona.
